

COVID Protocol for GSOA

Here is what we need to do for all of us to be safe during this season. We did well last year and appreciate everyone's support to help all of us and the schools we worked for.

Requirements:

1. If you have received the COVID vaccine, there is no other requirements for you.
2. If you have not received the vaccines and do not plan to, we ask that you get tested at least once a week. If you test positive, you cannot work for 14 days.
3. If you have COVID, you are good to not be tested for 90 days.
4. If you have had the vaccine, please carry either your card, or a picture of your card with you in case a school asks to verify. The goals are to keep you safe.
5. There will be a few conferences that you will be able to work for that do not require vaccines or test.

Things to help you staff safe:

1. Take your temperature before leaving for the game site to be sure you have no fever.
2. You may wear a mask and gloves during the game if you would like. When talking with a coach, please stay at least 6 feet from them and wear your mask if you feel it's necessary.
3. You may use a whistle with covers, bags, or shields.
4. Stay 6 feet or more from the table crew when talking with them.
5. No touching, fist bumping or handshakes, etc. with players or coaches.
6. Stay away from the fans. Let the game administrator manage those situations.
7. You will have a Captain's meeting before each game, however, keep 6 feet from them and wear a mask if you chose to.
8. Try not to touch players on the court.
9. The officials and evaluators will be the only ones allowed in your dressing area. If this does not happen, Tony needs to know.
10. Conference policies will determine game operating protocols and will be followed by all game officials. Every attempt will be made by game management to provide officials with a safe working environment.
